

# Shute Harbour Restoration

## Project Update October 2018

The Shute Harbour marine facility was badly damaged during Severe Tropical Cyclone Debbie in March 2017. Restoration works to terminal buildings, jetties and pontoons will be undertaken by Whitsunday Regional Council, with eligible works receiving joint funding from the Commonwealth and State Governments under the Natural Disaster Relief and Recovery Arrangements (NDRRA).



## Latest News

### ***Detailed Design well underway***

Council recently awarded the tender for the detailed design of the new terminal facility and jetties to major design company AECOM. The design is expected to be completed by the end of the year and will be released to the public in the new year.

AECOM is preparing the design for Council based on preliminary concepts developed over the last year. These concepts and the detailed design have taken into account the feedback received during the consultation period in late 2017.

### ***Construction begins early 2019***

The new seawall will be the first stage of construction and is currently expected to begin in early 2019. During this time there will be less car parking available on ground level, with overflow parking available in the top car park. All car parking will remain free until the project finishes.

### **Queensland Government boat ramp**

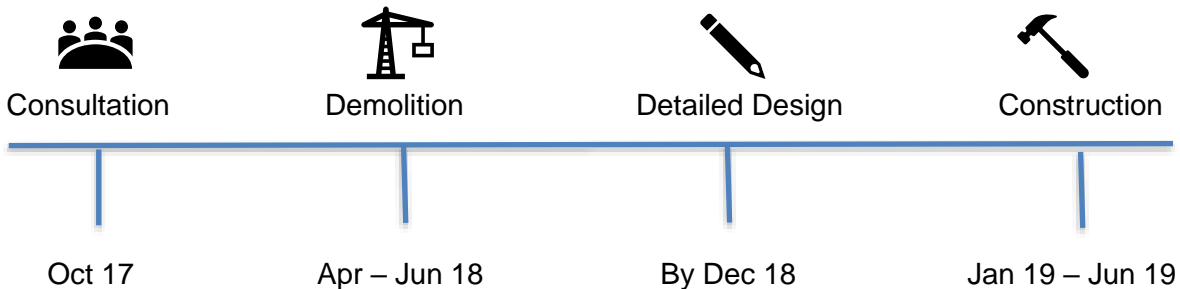
Transport & Main Roads have announced funding for a new recreational boat ramp at Shute Harbour. The new ramp aims to improve access to recreational boat launching facilities in the region, and will be designed to fit into the new seawall.

### **Pontoon removals begin in November 2018**

The damaged pontoons currently sitting on Snows Beach will also be removed from the beach in mid November and will be transported to another facility to be cleaned and stored until it is time for their restoration on site. This will also ensure the pontoons are not damaged further as we enter into storm season.
