Approach

Whitsunday Regional Council asked the community for feedback before making a decision whether to apply for a postal ballot in the 2020 local government elections.

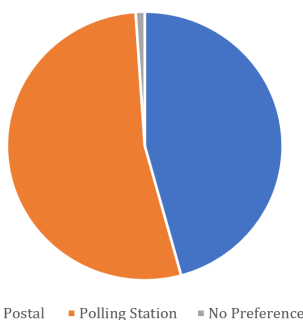
Council needed to apply for a postal ballot by 1 July 2019, and held public consultation over 4 weeks during May 2019.

Public display stalls were held at Bowen, Cannonvale, Collinsville, Conway Beach, Dingo Beach and Proserpine.

Residents could also participate online at Your Say Whitsunday, or submit written feedback by post or in person at any of Council's Customer Service Centres.

Postal v Polling Station

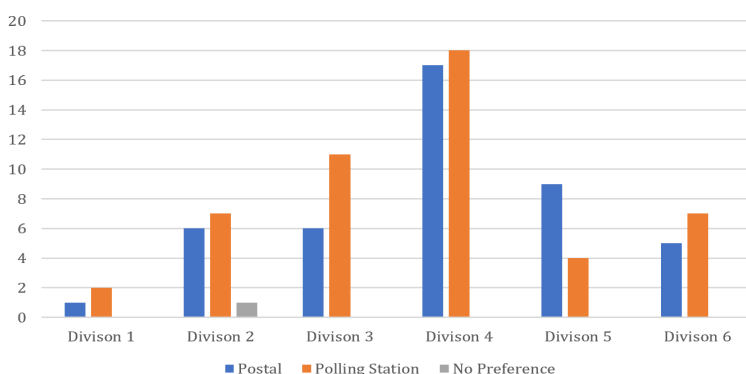


Next Steps
